- **5. Acknowledgments:** If there are people or resources that were particularly helpful in completing your project, be sure to acknowledge them.

Keep your synopsis brief and to the point, ideally no more than one to two paragraphs in length.

Write a query that selects the top 10 most profitable products from a sales database. You can use the SUM() function to calculate the total revenue generated by each product and ORDER BY to sort the results.


- **6.** Design a database scheme for a music streaming service that allows users to search for songs, create playlists, and rate songs.
